ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.) We propose to set 500' of 8-5/8" with mud, then drill to approx. 700'. If water is encountered between 500' and 700' we will pull the 8-5/8", run 700' of 8-5/8" and set with 50 sacks of cement. If no water is encountered we will pump the mud and set the 500' of 8-5/8" with 50 sacks of cement.

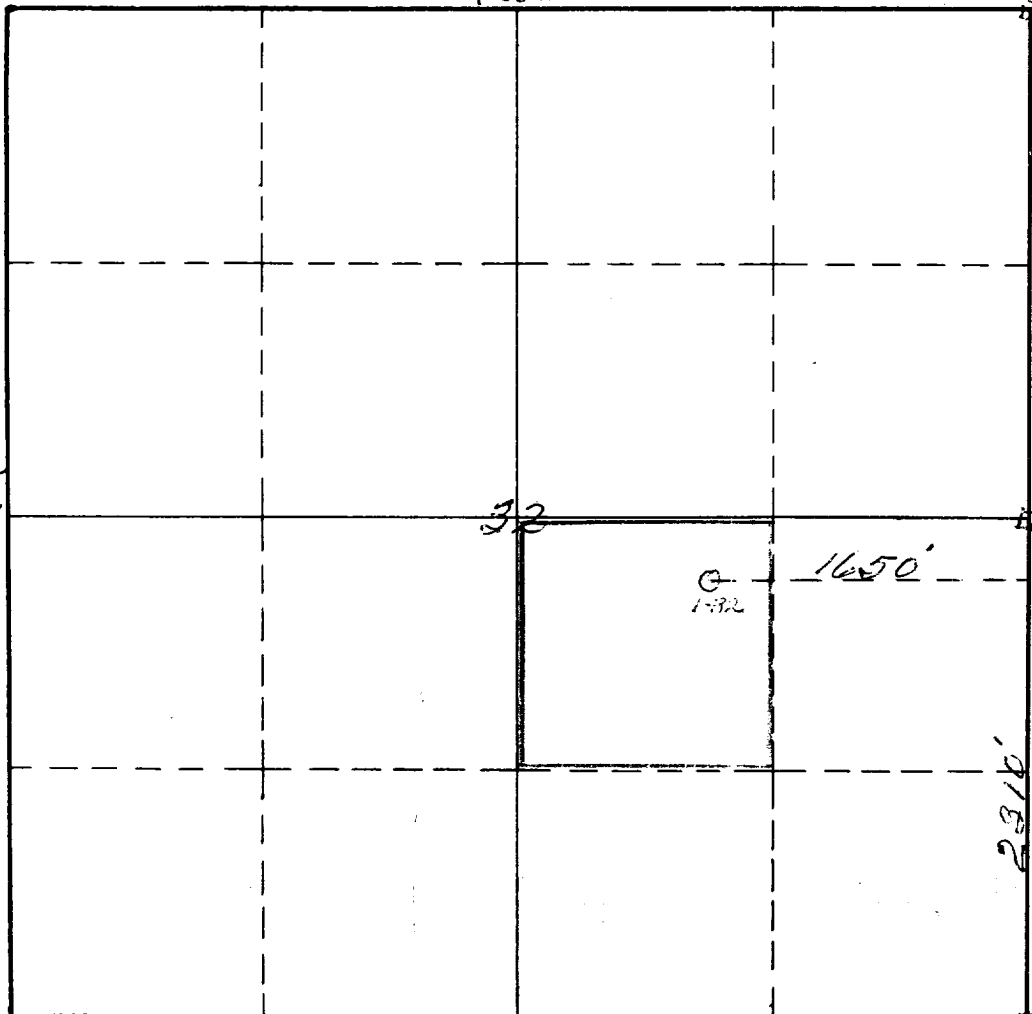
