Gentlemen:

In your Statewide Oil Proration Order for April 1962, it is found that you granted the above described well in the Empire Abo Field a daily allowable of 12 barrels of oil. This well has previously been awarded a full unit allowable. It is thought that perhaps the 12 barrel allowable for the Month of April was granted on the basis of our Gas-Oil Ratio report furnished you March 12, 1962. Production during this Gas-Oil Ratio test was reported to be 12 barrels oil and 13.6 MCF of gas. This production was based on a four hour test using an 8/64" choke. Had the test been extended over a 24-hour period, this well would have produced approximately 72 barrels oil and 81.6 MCF of gas.

This is to request that the full daily allowable for April be restored to this well since it is fully capable of making 62 barrels of oil per day and that the production granted not be based on the basis of a 4-hour GOR test.
