REGULATIONS FOR THE PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE

Section 1. The Department of Conservation, New Mexico, do hereby establish the following regulations for the protection of wildlife:

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, kill, capture, or take any wild animal, bird, or fish, or to possess, sell, or transport any such animal, bird, or fish, or any part thereof, or any product thereof, or any article made thereof, or to attempt to do any of the foregoing, or to aid, abet, or assist in the commission of any of the foregoing, or to violate any of the provisions of this section.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, kill, capture, or take any wild animal, bird, or fish, or to possess, sell, or transport any such animal, bird, or fish, or any part thereof, or any product thereof, or any article made thereof, or to attempt to do any of the foregoing, or to aid, abet, or assist in the commission of any of the foregoing, or to violate any of the provisions of this section.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, kill, capture, or take any wild animal, bird, or fish, or to possess, sell, or transport any such animal, bird, or fish, or any part thereof, or any product thereof, or any article made thereof, or to attempt to do any of the foregoing, or to aid, abet, or assist in the commission of any of the foregoing, or to violate any of the provisions of this section.
