  - \* 2 1/2" casing shot off at 200' and pulled
  - \* Heavy mud placed 2021' to 2080' - base of 4 1/2" casing
  - \* 15' Cement plug at 2080-2095'
  - \* 5' Cement plug 1984-1989' with half in and half above slab.
  - \* 5' Cement plug base of salt 1915-989
  - \* 5' Cement plug 450-500' which straddles surface pipe shoe at 471'
  - \* 15' Cement plug and slab with marker set in same.
- The cement has not yet been moved from lease but lease will be closed very soon. This will be reported as soon as it is done.
