FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The subject well was drilled to a total depth of 2440' without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantities. Temporarily abandoned but not plugged.

Permission is requested to plug and abandoned the well as follows: Pull approximately 1500' 4 1/2" casing. Set cement plugs as follows: 100' plug with 8 sacks 2437-2337; 100' plug with 15 sacks across top of 4 1/2" casing, ~~Set cement approx.~~ 1550-1450; 100' plug with 25 sacks across bottom of surface pipe 765-665; set 25 feet cement plug at surface with 6 sacks.

Fill void space between plugs with 12 lb./gal. mud. Erect a 4" X 4" marker at surface. Restore location to original condition.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of the above work.
