Work Done: Rigged up cable tools, found well clean, drilled Cal Seal plug to 3362'. Ran 3355' of 5 1/2" 15.5# casing and cemented with 230 sacks of class C cement. Ran Cement Evaluation Log and Gamma Ray Log, perforated from 3282-86, 3290-92, and 3302-12 in the Keely zone. Sand fraced with 50,000# 20/40 sand, 5500# 10/20 sand carried in 1658 barrels of fresh water. Maximum pressure 3200#. Initial shut down pressure 2200#. Swabbed portion of frac water sack, placing well on test if commercial production is obtained will file form G-102 requesting an allowable. First stage of workover complete.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
