DATE October 1, 1960

PURPOSE: ALLOWABLE REVIEW

Effective October 1, 1960, the allowable of the Western Development Co. of Delaware, Leonard Federal, Wells No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6, 33-17-29, Grayburg Jackson Pool are hereby increased as follows:

Well No. 1-C, 33-17-29  
increased from 9 to 15 barrels daily or 450 barrels for the month.

Well No. 2-E, 33-17-29  
increased from 15 to 21 barrels daily or 630 barrels for the month.

Well No. 3-F, 33-17-29  
increased from 15 to 21 barrels daily or 630 barrels for the month.

Well No. 4-D, 33-17-29  
increased from 15 to 21 barrels daily or 630 barrels for the month.

Well No. 5-L, 33-17-29  
increased from 15 to 21 barrels daily or 630 barrels for the month.

Well No. 6-K, 33-17-29  
increased from 15 to 21 barrels daily or 630 barrels for the month.
