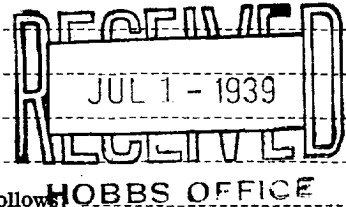

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: Size of Hole, Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented, Sacks Cement. Rows include 10" casing (8 1/4" size, 28# weight, Second Hand, 475' depth, Cemented, 50 sks) and 8" casing (7" O.D., 20# weight, New, 2600' depth, Cemented, 100 sks).

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 2650' feet.
