Set 5 1/2" O.D. at 3104' and cemented with 100 sacks. Drilled to total depth 3413' (SLM-3417'). Plugged back to 3386, washed with 200 gallons acid and treated with 1000 gallons; bridge back to 3300' and treated with 4000 gallons acid. Plugged back to 3235 and treated w/6000 gallons. No oil encountered at any depth.
