Dear Mr. Trujillo:

We received your notice concerning the McIntyre 2-A well in Unit P, Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 30 East.

This is an old well completed in 1940 that did not have sufficient production to market commercially; however, we have been using approximately 15 MCF of gas per month on the lease.

In January 1963 Mr. Shook with the United States Geological Survey advised us the well should be classified as a producer. We are enclosing a copy of his opinion. We filed a Supplementary Well History with the U.S.G.S. (copy enclosed) and began including the well on our January 1963 reports, with both the U.S.G.S. and your office.

We will appreciate your advising us further how we should report this well on Form C-115, or if it should be included on the report at all. We will await further instructions before filing an amended report.
