Dear Mr. Armstrong:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation this morning, we are enclosing Form C-127 requesting top allowable to commence on September 4 for the above well which was treated on September 2, 1964.

At the end of a 20 hour test this morning, the well had flowed 149 barrels of oil and 55 barrels of water. The gas - oil ratio as indicated by the casinghead gas purchaser's chart was 1353 to 1. As I stated this morning, we are requesting that we not be required to make the 30 - 60 days gas - oil ratio test as we do not want to choke the well back to take the test in fear that it will load up with water, and there is a possibility that it might cease to flow.

The regular gas - oil ratio test required by the OCC was made on June 20, 1964 and the gas - oil ratio was 1698 to 1. The well was on pump as of June 20 and pumped 84 barrels water and 42.19 barrels of oil. Since there is a water problem in this well, we would appreciate very much permission to forego the 30 - 60 days test required after treating. We would like to not choke the well back any more than necessary to keep production within the limits of the allowable.

Your help and consideration are very much appreciated.
