DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was mudded from the total depth of 3400' back to 3360', bridged and cemented back to 3300'. Test was made for water shut-off after 72 hours. No water appeared in the hole. It was mudded back to 1450', bridged and ten sacks cement dumped. It was mudded back to 500' and cemented with ten sacks cement. It was then mudded to surface where proper marker was set and cemented - location has been cleaned and leveled.
