DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set bridging plug @ 2850', loaded casing with water located hole in casing with Baker Retrievable Retainer @ 1057'. Pumped in 70 sacks cement. Bradenhead pressure built up to 400# finished at 250#, left 30' cement in casing above hole, drilled out plug and tested with 750# Surface pressure. Repair job O.K. Bailed water, filled hole with oil, drilled bridging plug from casing. Preparing to put well on pump.
