Drilled out cement in casing from 7040' to 7085', 6-17-69 to 6-27-69.

Drilled deeper from 7085' to 7095' T.D., 6-30-69 to 7-5-69. Fluid level was static - 3800'.

Shot well with 340 quarts of Nitroglycerin from 6759-7095. Trapped shot with 194' of shot gravel, and heavy mud plug, on 7-8-69.

Shot went off pre-maturely and ruptured casing - 3541'. Wedged out 2' of casing to 4 3/4".

Segment of casing fell in and lodged around sledge, cut drilling line, and bumped tools to 6765'. Ran magnet un-successfully. Jarred on tools for 40 hours, and did not move them.

Placed well on pump, and pumped dry.

Spotted 500 gallons of super mud acid on top of bridge, and pressured casing to 2500 psi.

Held pressure for 6 days with no real loss of pressure. Circulated hole with water.

Propose to shut well in temporarily, and evaluate log for future water disposal well, or producer from shallow zones.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
