2. Perforated 7" OD casing and 4-1/2" OD liner with one shot per interval at the following depths: 3085', 3099', 3106', 3126', 3146', 3156', 3173', 3193', 3199', 3234', 3282', 3310', 3318', 3327', 3340', 3353', 3360', 3370', 3377', 3393', 3399', 3415', 3421', for a total of 23 shots.
3. Treated through perforations 3234-3421' with 2000 gallons 15% Regular Acid and 14 ball sealers.
4. Treated through perforations 3085-3199' with 1500 gallons 15% Regular Acid and 32 ball sealers.
5. Treated through perforations 3085-3199' with 15,000 gallons treated water and 15,000# 20/40 sand.
6. Pulled retrievable bridge plug from 3208'.
7. Ran tubing and rods.
8. Well pumped 5 barrels of oil in 24 hours.
