This well is completed in the Seven Rivers open-hole section 2102-2307'. The following work was done to shut off water from the Grayburg-San Andres Formation:

1. Moved in Workover Rig 11:00 a.m. 5-28-69. Pulled rods and tubing.
2. Reran tubing with 6-1/4" bit and cleaned out to 2389'.
3. Ran Tracer Survey which indicated source of water at 2050'.
4. Ran cement retainer and set at 2384'.
5. Ran Tracer Survey which indicated water source at 2078', 2324', 2343' and 2384'.
6. Ran cast iron bridge plug on tubing and set plug at 2379'.
7. Ran 2-3/8" OD tubing, perforations 2277-80'. Ran rods with pump set at 2276'. Tested.
8. This well is still being pumped and tested and is making approximately 16 bbls. of water per day through open-hole section 2102-2307' of the Seven Rivers Formation.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
