 - 2) Pull and lay down rods. Install BOP. Pull and lay down 119 jts. 2 3/8" tbg.
 - 3) RIH with 6 1/8" bladed bit, jet wash sub, and 2 7/8" workstring. Jet wash open hole from 3432'-3788'. Clean out to 3788'-98'.
 - 4) Spot 750 gals. 15% NEFE double inhibited acid from 2990'-3430'. POH.
 - 5) Perforate from 3041' to 3429' with 4" csg. guns, 2 JSPI @ 3041', 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 49, 80, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90, 92, 3112, 14, 42, 44, 46, 48, 60, 69, 71, 73, 75, 77, 79, 81, 83, 85, 87, 90, 3235, 37, 39, 41, 65, 70, 76, 87, 3302, 06, 08, 10, 32, 62, 90, 99, 3403, 05, 07, 09, 11, 26, 28, and 29. Total 56 int., 112 perfs.
 - 6) RIH with 7" pkr. on 2 7/8" tbg. Set pkr. at 3224'. Load backside with 2% KCL water.
 - 7) Acidize perfs from 3041'-3429' (156 holes) and open hole from 3432'-3798' with 3402 gals. of 15% NEFE acid, 162-1.3 SG ball sealers, and 1000# of rock salt in gelled brine @ 4 BPM.
 - 8) Swab back load.
 - 9) Release pkr. Lower pkr. across perfs. POH.
 - 10) RIH with 7" retrievable bridge plug, pkr. and 2 7/8" tbg. Set RBP @ 3220'. Set pkr. @ 2986'.
 - 11) Acidize perfs 3041'-3200' (67 holes) with 3000 gals. of 15% NEFE acid, 70-1.3 SG ball sealers, and 200# of rock salt.
 - 12) Swab.
 - 13) Release pkr. POH.
 - 14) RIH with 2 3/8" 4.7# J-55 EUE IPC tbg. and 7" Baker AD-1 IPC pkr. to 2963'.
 - 15) Set pkr. @ 2963'.
 - 16) Change out wellhead, and place on injection.
 - 17) RDPU.
 - 18) Converted to water injection well on 2/13/87.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
