We drilled this well to a total depth of 2528 feet.

On April 9, 1965 we ran 2526 feet of 5½" casing, cementing with 150 sacks.

After waiting 48 hours for cement to set, Halliburton treated thru perforations, 2476 feet to 2482 feet, 2 shots per foot, with 27,000 lbs. 20/40 sand, 3,000 lbs. 10/20 sand and 26,670 gallons of oil.

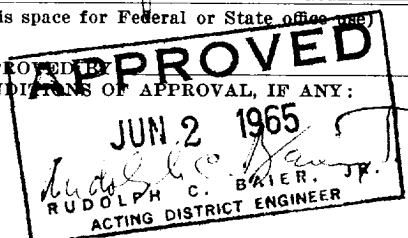

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
