Gentlemen:

Following is the Development Plan for Surface use in association with the Application to Drill the Windfohr Oil Company Jackson "B" #29, to be located 1980' FSL and 1830' FWL of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- (1) Existing roads are shown by solid red lines on the attached map, in the immediate proximity of the proposed location.
- (2) The location falls near an existing county road and lease road and an additional road will be necessary.
- (3) Locations of existing wells are shown on the attached map.
- (4) Lateral roads to well locations are covered by (1) and (2).
- (5) Oil will be piped to the existing tank battery.
- (6) Water will be purchased at Lordsburg, New Mexico, and hauled to rig.
- (7) The method for handling all waste disposal will be a waste pit at the location, to be covered up after drilling is completed.
- (8) The proposed rig is a 40' x 60'.
- (9) The proposed rig is a 40' x 60'.
- (10) The drilling rig layout will be as shown on the attached plan. The drilling pit will be located outside.
- (11) Plans for reclamation of the surface include filling and leveling of a pit.
- (12) Other information - The proposed location is in flat country with small sand dunes scattered with weeds, vetch, and small reed grass. No gulches or rivers are in the vicinity of the proposed drilling site.
