The following zones were broken down separately with small amounts of acid, starting with top zone and going down. No communication was evident: 2894-2901 and 2906-11, 2940-52, 3044-78 and 3193-3210. The following frac treatments were given on Feb. 28, 1977:

3193-3210 - Frac w/20,000 gals. Redifrac 40 + 16,500# sand, all treatments containing 2 gals/1,000 gals. of Protex-All.

3044-78 - Frac/31,000 gals. Redifrac + 26,000# sand in 2 stages.

2894-2952 - Frac/31,000 gals. Redifrac 40 + 26,000# sand in 2 stages.
Treated at 2 BPM @ 2600-1600 psi.

Instructions
