- 1. EXISTING ACCESS ROADS Area map, Exhibit G, shows existing access road in yellow. All roads shall be maintained in a condition equal that which existed prior to the start of construction.
 - A. Exhibits G & H show the proposed Morrow well site as staked.
 - B. From Loco Hills, New Mexico, travel south 4/10 miles on County Road #217. Turn left on caliche road. Travel 1/2 mile east. Turn right (south) for 3/10 mile to wellsite (150' west of Federal S Well #2).
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS No new access roads will be necessary for this well.
 - A. Exhibit G shows that no new access road will be necessary.
- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS IN A ONE MILE RADIUS
 - A. Water Wells None.
 - B. Disposal Wells One in the SW/4 of Sec. 21 as shown on Exhibit H (in green).
 - C. Drilling Wells None.
 - D. Producing Wells As shown on Exhibit H (in orange).
 - E. Abandoned Wells As shown on Exhibit H (in blue).

- 5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY Water will be purchased locally from a private source and trucked over the access road or piped in flexible lines laid on top of the ground.
