DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Dec. 21st. 1952 we ran 327' of 8 5/8" 28# L.W. casing and cemented with 100 sacks. After cement set 120 hrs. we drilled out to bottom. we then took a bailing test showing 10 gal. per hr. After drilling ahead the water seems to have decreased to where we are adding the normal amount of drilling water. At approx. 2400' we plan to take another water test. If the hole is still making water we will run enough mud behind the oil string to circulate to surface.
