We plan to enter the State 648 No. 75 well, drilled and abandoned March 3, 1937, clean out to old TD of 2238', run 4 1/2" OD casing, log, perforate and treat to inject water into the Grayburg formation. Indications are now that well records are incorrect and the surface casing has been pulled. If this proves to be true, 7" OD casing will be set and cemented through the salt. A well location plat is attached.

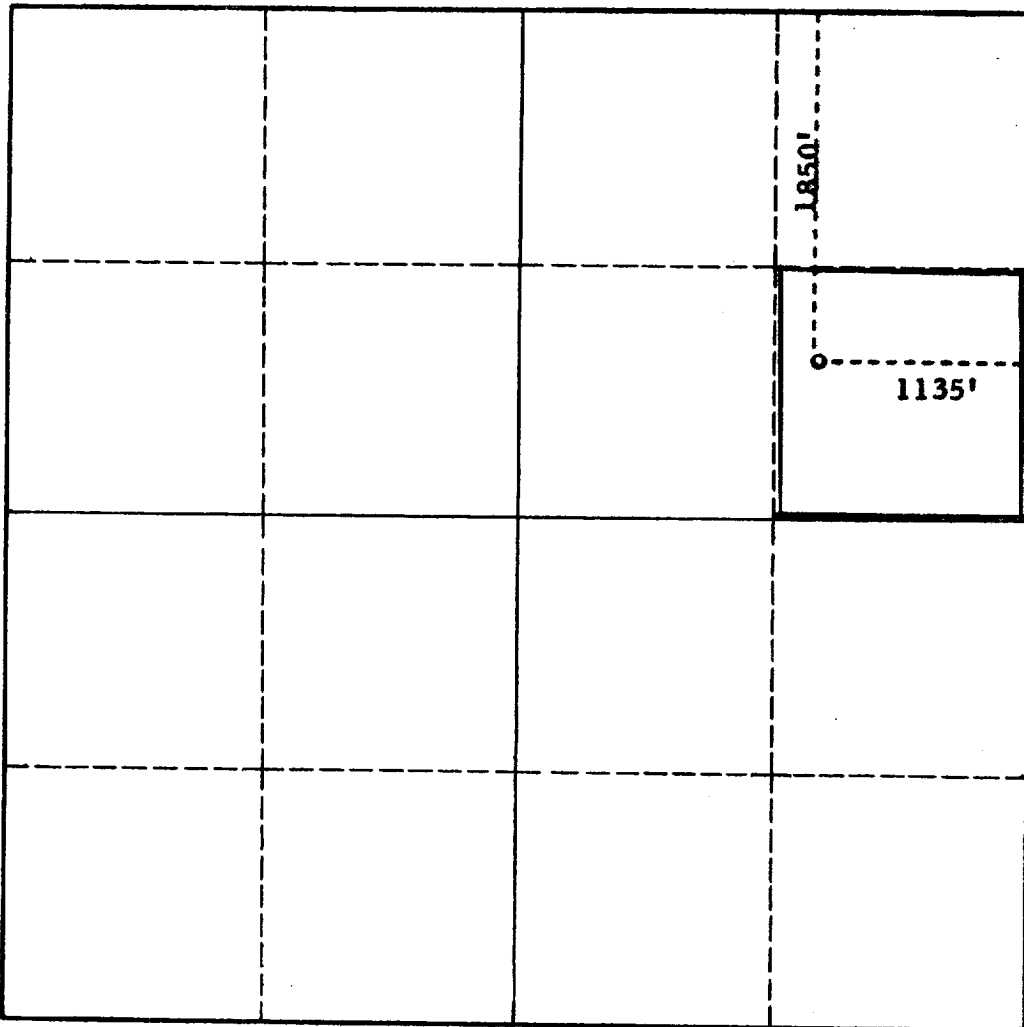


Gentlemen:

Attached are the required copies of Form C-128 for the subject well which has a current plugged and abandoned status. We would like to direct your attention to previous records, Form C-105, which indicated the subject well to be located as follows: 660' North of the South line and 200' East of the West line of the NE/4 of NE/4 of Section 10, T-18-S, R-28-E. Other well records indicate the well to be in the SW/4 of NE/4 as is shown on Exhibit No. 2 of the Application for Water Flood (Case No. 2492).

In view of these discrepancies in the records, Well No. 75 has been resurveyed and its actual location was found to be as follows: 1850' FNL and 1135' FEL, Section 10, T-19-S, R-28-E.
