DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 2" upset tubing to 2200'.

Circulated 30 sacks of aquagel to surface. Twenty sacks cement plug from 2200-2140; 20 sack cement plug from ~~IN~~ 1395-1335; 100 sack cement plug 790-650; and 20 sack cement plug 392-332. Cement was mixed with salt brine in order not to dilute the water.

Four sacks calcium chloride went in the cement.

This work was done by the Denton Cementing Company, and done under the supervision of the State Engineer and also the SW Potash Company Engineers.
