Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated February 22, 1956, covering your well No. 1-Yates "A" located in the SW¹/₄ section 28, T. 19 S., R. 30 E., Wildcat Area, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent you on request and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Furnish this office with duplicate copies of any electric logs or surveys run, and/or duplicate copies of a sample description log from the base of the salt to the total depth, in addition to five copies of our log of oil or gas well, form 7-330.
3. Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness the cementing operations and water shut off tests.
4. The drilling and casing program must conform with the applicable provisions of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-111, dated November 9, 1951.

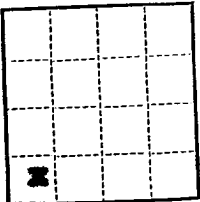

DETAILS OF WORK

We intend drilling this well to an approximate depth of 1800' or a sufficient depth to test the Yates Sand. 8-5/8" casing will be run and cemented at approximately 1800'; with sufficient cement to circulate to surface or collar. 5-1/2" casing will be run to approximately 1750' and cemented with sufficient cement to circulate back to surface.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
