Dear Sir:

Our Greenwood Unit Well No. 1, located in Unit "P", Section 27, T-18-S, R-31-E, Wildcat Field, Eddy County, New Mexico, was completed February 20, 1957, as a shut-in gas well.

We anticipate the Potash Company of America will commence taking gas from this well Monday, July 22, 1957, and Forms C-110 and C-128 are being forwarded to Mr. Armstrong in your Artesia office to designate them as transporter. Form C-110 authorizing Indiana Oil Purchasing Company (Trucks) to transport distillate was submitted and approved by your office March 8, 1957. This designation of temporary transporter will remain in effect for the next few days until Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company is able to make a permanent pipe line connection, at which time a revised Form C-110 will be submitted.

We hereby request a distillate allowable of 600 barrels per day to be effective July 22, 1957 (a total of 6000 barrels for the month of July) be granted in order that condensate produced with gas can be disposed of when gas sales are commenced to the Potash Company of America.
