Swabbed wtr. 3080-3140' acidized with 500 gal. Swabbed wtr. 2250-2340' swabbed formation wtr. 3605-3695' swabbed formation wtr. no treatment, no show of oil or gas. 4700-5300' acidized with 2000 gal. swabbed - no oil or gas. SD to prepare to plug and abandon as follows: 15 sx of cnt. over top of bridge plug set at 6970'. Interval of cnt. 6896-6970'. 15 sx over Wolfcamp perms. Interval of 5520-5620' 35 sx across the stub of 5 1/2" csg. 50' above and 50' below the stub; 80 sx cnt. Interval 3475-3675'. 75 sx cnt. Interval 1000-1100' or 7670-7770'. Top sx of cnt. on top of surface and 2 sx around location marker. Cleaned up location.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
