DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

- (1) On December 15, 1946, 11-3/4" - 54# - R3 - A. O. Smith S-80 slip joint casing was cemented at 614' by Halliburton in 15 1/2" and 15" hole with 400 sacks bulk cement. No returns were noted but set cement was found 3' below the cellar floor.
- (2) On 12-17-46, the plug was located at 596' and 1050# was applied with no loss in 30 min. The cement was cleaned out and 1050# was applied and 50# loss was noted in one hour.
