I talked to one of the partners, Mr. C. C. Curry, in Carlsbad yesterday and he told me that a Mr. Murry and a Mr. McKinnon may take over the operation of this well and complete it or if they don't take it over Binkley and Curry will probably plug and abandon it in the near future.

The well is at a total depth of 763 feet, with a rock bit and one joint of 4-1/2 inch drill pipe twisted off at total depth. Operations were suspended June 10, 1952.

I will keep you informed as to any changes in operators or if the well is plugged.
