Your letter of April 2, 1941, regarding your well No. 2, in Section 15-21 S-27 E, Eddy County, New Mexico, received.

After checking the above mentioned well I find the only record we have on this well is a notice of intention to drill. Before plugging a well on State or Fee land in New Mexico, you must ask for permission to plug on our Form C-102, and when that has been granted, make out results of plugging on our Form C-103 and also, furnish us with a log of the well made out on our Form C-105.

In regard to drilling another well, you will have to submit another bond for the approval of the Oil Conservation Commission before you can start operations.
