FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well was drilled to total depth of 1101' in anhydrite and 5/8" of 32, CR-40 SS.
Casing string was run and set at 1093' with 50 sacks of cement on September 30, 1944
at 3:00 P. M. On October 30, 3:00 P. M., 72 hours will have elapsed since setting casing
string and we plan to test casing shut off in the following manner:

Build up 1000 pressure and hold for thirty minutes, if test is O. K. Plug
will be drilled, after which pressure will again be built up to 1000 pressure and
held for thirty minutes; if this test, too, is O. K. drilling operations will be
resumed.
