Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company State "N" Well No. 1 in the Company or Operator Lease  
32 1/4 N. 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 20S, R. 31E, N. M. P. M.,  
Wildcat Field, Eddy County.

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 3d, at N. M., 74 hours had elapsed since a 5/8" 32, GA-40 SS Casing String was run and set at 1023' with 50 sacks of cement which was tested as follows: Hole was bailed dry, then plug was drilled with cable tools, after which hole was again bailed dry. As both tests indicated a satisfactory shut off had been obtained drilling operations were resumed. We were not able to test shut off as outlined on Form C-102, dated October 2, 1944, as pump necessary for building up pressure was not available. Therefore, a bailing test was made before and after drilling plug.
