Gentlemen:

We note that the Bogle Flats Unit Well No. 2 J, 4-22-23, in the subject pool, has 678.60 dedicated acres. Administrative approval of this non-standard proration unit should be obtained from our Santa Fe office.

Further, the USGS has informed this office that the acreage dedicated to the following described wells has been communitized: Bogle Flats Unit Well No. 1 and 6, and the Federal 33 well No. 1. Please file revised Form C-102s, Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat, for each well, showing the identity of working interests and royalty ownership as required. When unitized acreage is communitized with uncommitted acreage, the unit name only need be recorded for the unit acreage. It is not necessary for these plats to be signed by a surveyor.
