

- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced until they have dried and leveled.
- C. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the BLM will be complied with and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled level within 90 days after abandonment.

11. OTHER INFORMATION.

- A. Topography: The land surface in the vicinity of the wellsite is flat. The immediate area of the wellsite is discussed above in paragraph 9B.
- B. Flora and Fauna: The caliche pad is in place. No wildlife was observed but the wildlife in the area probably includes those typical of semi-arid desert land. The area is used for cattle grazing.
- C. Waterways: Pecos River is west approximately 5 miles.
- D. There are no inhabited dwellings in the vicinity of the proposed wellsite.
- E. Surface Ownership: Federal minerals and federal surface.
