Gentlemen:

Morris R. Antweil respectfully requests the granting of administrative approval to a nonstandard gas proration and spacing unit comprising the 297.4 acres being Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Section 4-T21S-R26E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to our No. 1 Western Reserves Federal to be drilled in Lot 11.

The unorthodox size of the requested unit is necessitated by the variation of the legal subdivisions of the U. S. Public Lands Surveys. Lots 3 and 4 to be dedicated to the proposed well contain only 28.65 and 28.75 acres, respectively; therefore, the total acreage available to the gas proration unit is 297.4 acres.
