MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to identify the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal may be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

The well, and work area have been staked by a registered New Mexico land surveyor. Geo-Marine Inc. has been engaged to make an Class III Archaeological Survey of the work area. A copy is attached for your reference, see attached exhibit "A".

1. <u>Existing Roads</u>

Directions to location:

From the junction of US Hwy 62/180 and county road 672, go West and Southwest on county road 672 for approximately 4.5 miles to a lease road; Thence South on lease road for approximately 0.75 mile to the Happy Valley "4" #22 well and the proposed lease road to the Ram Ewe Federal #6.
