3 Wells in T23S-R28E Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Williams:

Enclosed are three(3) separate C-103 forms (Sundry Notice) for procedure approvals on three Hallwood Petroleum, Inc. operated wells we plan to plug and abandon soon. These wells are all located within one(1) mile of each other (see attached map).

This letter is intended to point out our proposed P & A plans more in detail for each well and to request a modification of the plugging plans on the third well discussed below:

- 1) Cassidy Com #1 (Sec. 29-T23S-R28E) This P & A procedure was modified last November during a telephone discussion between M. Williams and K. O'Connell. We are simply re-submitting a new C-103 with the revised procedure to reflect the elimination of a plug at 9,620-9,720', and the combining of the Bone Spring plug and shallow ("freshwater") plugs as previously approved.
- 2) Guitar Estate #1 (Sec. 19-T23S-R28E) This P & A procedure is rather straight forward as the well is still perforated in the Morrow at 12,194-12,200'. We plan to set a CIBP and 35 feet of cement over these perfs and then set a Penn. plug, Wolfcamp/top of liner plug, Bone Spring plug, shoe/stub plug, and surface plugs very similar to the Cassidy Com #1.
