Event #1

In or about 1/93 a leak developed in flow line from well to tank battery, approximately 10 barrels of oil and 50 barrels of water was spilled. At that time equipment was sent to remove any liquids. When area was sufficiently dry a surfactant/oil dispersant and a nitrogen fertilizer was spread across the affected area, additional dirt was spread over the top. What remains today is a discoloration. There has been very little rain fall in this area since incident accrued to promote plant growth, no additional remediation is planed.

Event #2

Sometime after the completion of the well (11/12/92), the reserve pit dike broke allowing an unknown amount of drilling water to run off location. The drilling water did not contain any oil or hazardous wastes. This area should come back with its previous plant life when this area receives some rain.
