At 1730 hours on 8/30/93, we spud this new well. On 8/31/93, set ran 872' of 13 3/8" surface casing in a 17 1/2" open hole. The casing was cemented to surface with the following cement slurries:

500 sx LITE (35:65) +6% gel + 2% CaCl2 + 1/4 lb/sk cellophane flakes
200 sx Class "C" + 2% CaCl2 + 1/4 lb/sk cellophane flakes

We circulated 75 sacks of cement to surface.

NOTE: We ran 20 jts of 13 3/8", 48 ppf, H-40 8rd casing
