1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Point "A" on the plat is on State highway 128 at Milepost 13.7, approximately 20 miles east of Loving, New Mexico, where a caliche road goes south. To go to the proposed well site from this point, exit State 128 to the south and go south, east, and again south 4.4 miles, as shown, to arrive at Bettis, Boyle & Stovall's well No. 1 Lotos Federal. Also see Exhibits "B" and "D". The proposed well site is about 3960 feet east of this producing well.
- B. Exhibit "B" shows pertinent roads in the vicinity of the proposed well site. Existing roads are color coded.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: New road will be constructed from the Lotos Federal well No. I easterly to the proposed well site. The new road will be 15 feet wide and about 3900 feet long, and is shown labeled and color coded red on Exhibits "B" and "D". That portion of the new road located parallel to the existing pipeline is to be 50 feet from the pipeline. The centerline of the proposed new road is staked and flagged.
 - B. Surfacing Material: Caliche. Watered, compacted, and graded.
 - C. <u>Maximum Grade</u>: Less than one percent.
 - D. Turnouts: Possibly two.
- E. <u>Drainage Design</u>: The new road will be crowned with drainage to the side.
 - F. Culverts: None needed.
- G. <u>Cuts and Fills</u>: None necessary. However, minor levelling will be necessary.
 - H. Gates and Cattle Guards: None necessary. No fences involved.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

A. Existing wells in the immediate area are shown on Exhibit "B".
