Cory – BP has submitted a remediation plan to both the NMOCD and the BLM to execute excavation and soil shredding at this site. Based on conversation with the BLM, the remediation plan requires a NEPA review and must be approved/reviewed by the Navajo NEPA office in Flagstaff, AZ prior to approval.

Based on previous experience with this process, the approval can take anywhere from 2 weeks up to 18 months.

At this time BP will not meet the March 13, 2020 described below due to the Navajo NEPA processing timeline. The timeline for approval is unknown at this time.
