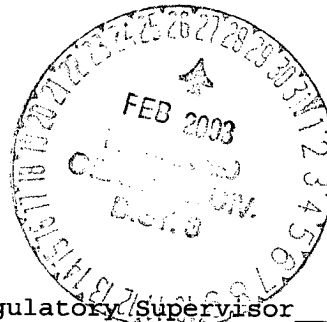

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to restimulate the Pictured Cliffs formation and recomplete to the Fruitland Coal formation in the subject well as follows:

Move in, rig up. Pull tubing. Set a retrievable bridge plug above the Pictured Cliffs perforations. Pressure test the casing. Pull retrievable bridge plug. Fracture stimulate the Pictured Cliffs formation. Set a retrievable bridge plug above the Pictured Cliffs perforations. Selectively perforate and fracture stimulate the Fruitland Coal formation. Clean out the wellbore and remove the retrievable bridge plug. The Fruitland Coal and Pictured Cliffs formations will then be commingled. Return the well to production. Attached is a C-102 plat. A down hole commingle application will be submitted.

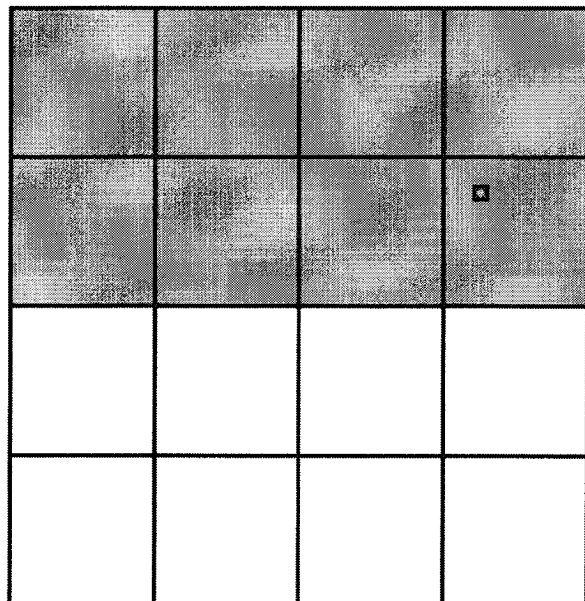
