It is intended to restimulate the Pictured Cliffs formation in the subject well as follows:

Move in, rig up. Pull tubing. Deepen the well to approximately 200 feet below the top of the Pictured Cliffs formation. Run production casing to total depth. Cement to surface. Fracture stimulate the Pictured Cliffs formation. Return well to production.
