3-26-04 Circ hole clean. TOOH. TIH w/3 jts 9 5/8" 32.3 H-40 ST&C csg, set @ 152'.
Pump 20 bbl wtr ahead. Cmdt w/127 sx Class "B" Type III cmt w/3% calcium
chloride, 0.25 pps Celloflake (179 cu.ft.). Displace w/10 bbl wtr. Circ
10 bbl cmt to surface. WOC. NU BOP. PT BOP & csg to 600 psi/30 min, OK.
Drilling ahead.

3-27-04 Drill to 1004'. Bit torque. Lost circ. TOOH. Pump 75 bbl LCM down hole.
TIH w/bit. Drill to 1034'. Have full returns, bit still having torque.
