Back in October 1938, we executed the above captioned bond for the above captioned Principal, being known as well No. 1 on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24 Township 29 North Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

We understand that this developed to be a water well, and also that with the proper forms filed that you could relieve us of liability when this was properly transferred for water purposes.

We have been unable to locate Mr. Noland, one of the partners, on this bond; however Mr. Bullock, we understand is at Olathe Colorado, and we have today requested him to make arrangements to have this well properly transferred.

We would appreciate you advising us as to what forms or information that needs to be completed in order to make the proper change.

Just wondering if you have had your inspector check this well and if you will advise us as to what is required, we will try to get the matter disposed of.
