13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. Proposed to commence April 1st, 2003:

- 1) Release pkr, lower to check for fill and POOH. If tbg appears unsound, lay down and pick-up 2-3/8" work string.
- 2) Run in hole w/RBP and pkr. Isolate csg leak. Set RBP below leak and dump about 100# sand on plug. POOH, LD pkr and run tbg open ended to a few feet below the leak.
- 3) If leak continues to be only a slow leak, mix 20 sx micro-matrix cement and spot out end of tbg as a balanced plug. Pull tbg up above cement and squeeze to at lease 500 psi.
- 4) WOC. Drill out cmt and test to 500 psi. If squeeze tests good, retrieve bridgeplug and re-run injection packer to about 50' above perforations.
- 5) Run integrity test and put well back on injection.
