Attached is a copy of the allocation for the subject well that was completed 12-9-02. DHC-958az was issued for this well.

These percentages are based upon the following information: attempts were made to lower water production during the completion. These attempts were unsuccessful. A spinner survey and a separator test were also attempted. They were also unsuccessful due to the excess water production. A pumping unit was installed and the well is producing 53 barrels of water a day. When the well is shut-in it takes at least five days to restore production. At this time it is too risky to shut-in and retest; the well may not recover. The offset wells for the respective formations were reviewed and found to be approximately equal confirming the 50/50% allocation for each formation.
