McElvain has returned this well to production on 10-6-2000.

If the well will not sustain commercial production volumes a recompletion will be evaluated. If a Mesaverde recompletion is attempted note that the acreage dedicated is changed from 160 to 320 and would require a new com agreement. Also note that the location would have to be approved as a nonstandard. This recompletion would be started at some future date depending on resolution of the nonstandard location as well as rig and services availability.
