This well was shut in on April 2, 2004, due to loss of a gas market. A new contract to market the gas from this well is presently being negotiated with the owner of the Helium Plant. Before this well can return to production under a new contract some other issues must be settled with the Navajo Nation. The issues are:

- 1. A ROW agreement must be attained for the Gathering System(approximately ten miles) that transports the gas to the Helium Plant.
- 2. A ROW agreement must be attained for looping a two mile pipeline to the existing 8" pipeline in the DBK Field that transports gas from the DBK Field into the Gathering system. The produced volume from the DBK Field combined with the gas volume from the Beautiful Mountain Field, are necessary to economically operate the Helium Plant.
- 3. With ROW approvals, an order will be submitted for 2 miles of Fiberglass Pipe, with a 60-90 day delivery time plus approximately 2 weeks will be required for installation and testing.
- 4. Mr. Aktar Zaman is handling this matter, however he fell and injured his back and is away from work, his mother passed away in Pakistan, and he is not scheduled to return to work until September. When he returns to work and is satisified with the ROW agreement he will then present them to the Tribal Council for their final approval.
- 5. Winter weather will soon be present in the DBK Field which will delay the installation of the pipeline. Mountain States Petroleum Corp.., will be ready to purchase and install pipeline and return this well to production, when all the aforementioned issues are settled, however we would estimate and request approval to leave the Navajo 5 No. 1 well shut in until October 1, 2005.
