**Re: Request for Extension of Implementation Period for Division Order SWD-878.**

Dear Ms. Waller:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has reviewed your request to extend the implementation period on the Stanolind Gas Com "D" Well No. 1 (API 30-045-23779) located 1,820 feet from the South line and 1,590 feet from the East line Lot 10 of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, originally approved with Division order SWD-878. **Providing that all conditions contained in the order remain the same and there are no new wells drilled in the area of review, the expiration date of the SWD-878 is hereby extended to October 8, 2004.**

In the event any drilling activity occurs in the subject area of review, XTO Energy Inc. will notify the supervisor of the Aztec district office and the Division office. An administrative review of the permit will be conducted, and the status of the permit will be determined.

**Additionally: The operator shall report by sundry to the Aztec district office (send a copy to Santa Fe), the original static fluid levels – in units of feet from the KB - for both zones completed during the work-over to convert to injection.**

All other provisions and conditions of SWD-878 and Division Rules 706 and 1120 shall remain in full force and effect.
